A well-rounded program will consist of rules, etiquette, and instructional clinics as well as fun activities that will promote the learning experience. Throughout the instruction sessions, we will incorporate game-based learning to create fun and competitive learning.

The most important aspect of our clinics will be creating a fun experience for juniors so they can reach their highest potential through basic instructional programming. Game Fundamentals, Etiquette & Rules, and Swing Fundamentals are just a few things our team will focus on to improve all junior golfers.

2025 Season

Beginner Sessions:

Our **beginner sessions** is for those who want to be introduced to the game of golf. Ages are usually between 4 and 10 who have not been on the golf course much. Clubs are NOT NEEDED. We will be using the **S.N.A.G.** Golf equipment for this camp, along with other sports and their relation to golfing. The clinic will run from 9:00am - 10:00am, (**Members and Non-Members are welcome**) and includes instruction, use of equipment, and party after final session. Juniors may be dropped off between 9:00-10:00 and should be picked up after each class.

Advanced Sessions:

Our **advanced sessions** are for juniors who have played golf before or have had individual instruction. Ages are generally 8-14 years of age. There will be more instruction during these sessions to fine tune special skills. We will be going over rules of the game, swing mechanics and course management. The sessions will be from 10:30am – 11:30am. The cost includes instruction, use of course, range balls, and party after final session. (**Members and Non-Members are welcome**) Juniors may be dropped off between 10:30am – 11:30am and should be picked up after each class.
